Leeds City Region Future Mobility Zone Fund – confirmation of local match funding

Here in Calderdale we have been committed to the development of Mobility Hubs as an innovative solution to encourage positive modal change for some time. The Corridor Improvement Programme (CIP) is a key part of our West Yorkshire Plus Transport Fund programme. We have been leading our region in the identification of Mobility Hubs as part of the CIP programme and have progressed to the point of an approved Outline Business Case having identified £500,000 for the delivery of Mobility Hubs in the CIP area. As such we are in a position where we have it formally agreed that these monies will progress towards Full Business Case with the principle that CIP can fund Mobility Hub related works.
