<p>Title/Subject: West Yorkshire Financial Exploitation and Abuse Team – Three-month grant extension 01 Oct 2021 to 31 Dec 2021, with a provisional further three-month extension to 31st March 2022, subject to mainstreaming conditions.</p>

<p>Summary: The purpose of this paper is to request an extension to the WYFEAT grant until 31st December 2021, with the provision of a further three-month extension to 31st March 2022, to continue to tackle the growing threat of fraud and cyber-crime targeting vulnerable people. This grant will be made in two stages, firstly from 1st October 2021 to 31st December 2021, which will facilitate mainstreaming options being investigated. If mainstreaming is agreed, a grant extension from 1st January 2022 to 31st March 2022 will be offered to facilitate mainstreaming implementation without a loss of service capacity.</p>
<p>Requested Decision: That the Mayor of West Yorkshire extends the funding of WYFEAT for three-months, to the end of December 2021, to facilitate mainstreaming discussions with West Yorkshire Police and WY District Adult Social Care departments. If mainstreaming agreed, a further three-month extension will be provided to 31st March 2022 to the end of the financial year.</p>
