



### Record of Decision made in respect of the Mayor's Police and Crime Commissioner functions

<b>Title/Subject:</b> Submission of bid to Home Office's Safer Street Fund Two FY21/22
<b>Serial No:</b> DP MPCC 0210 - SSF2 - Vehicle Crime in the M62 corridor
<b>Summary:</b> The West Yorkshire Police and Crime Commissioner submitted a bid to tackle vehicle crime along the M62 corridor in March 2021. The bid focuses on the districts of Kirklees, Calderdale and Wakefield, introducing CCTV, improved street lighting, ANPR cameras and bespoke crime prevention campaigns, to target harden and reduce vehicle crime in higher crime rate areas.
<b>Requested Decision:</b> That the Deputy Mayor Policing and Crime supports the submission and delivery of the SSF2 bid and agrees to grant delivery partners allocated monies of £306,317 to achieve the deliverables by March 2022.
