

### Record of Decision made in respect of the Mayor's Police and Crime Commissioner functions

<b>Title/Subject:</b> Violence Reduction Unit – Education Inclusion work stream 2021-22
<b>Serial No:</b> MPCC043
<b>Summary:</b> The VRU's Response Strategy retains education inclusion as a priority from the previous year and a total of £200,000 has been allocated for delivery in this area, aimed at contributing to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Increased attendance</li><li>• Reduced exclusions (fixed term and permanent)</li></ul> Reflecting on the research evidence, a pilot is proposed at a selected Secondary School in Wakefield, along with its core feeder primary schools. The learning from this pilot will be shared county-wide and inform any future funding allocations which could then be replicated in other districts based on the Public Health Approach to Reducing Violence.
<b>Requested Decision:</b> That the DMPC approves the VRU to commission Education Inclusion focused interventions against funding of £200,000 to deliver against intended outcomes.
