

Ministry of Justice Grant Funding in Relation to Local Commissioning of Victims' Support Services for West Yorkshire.

The following information is an overview of all the commissioned services and projects with allocated funding for the financial years 2022/23, 2023/24 and 2024/25. The allocations are subject to change and this information will be updated every 3 months or as required to reflect changes in allocations.

Policing and Crime have ensured all organisations have a proven track record of providing tailored services for particular groups including Black African/Caribbean and Southeast Asian people and other minority ethnic people who have experienced racism (BME: Black, Minority Ethnic people), disabled people, Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer/Questioning, Intersex, and Asexual/Allies, Non-Binary (LGBTQIA+) and male victims.
